<p>Mobile Phones</p> 	Without the permission of the arbiter, a player is forbidden to have a mobile phone or other electronic means of communication in the playing venue, unless they are completely switched off. If any such device produces a sound, the player shall lose the game.
Clocks/Recording of Moves	Clocks will be used for the tournament. Recording of moves is necessary. Note it is no longer permitted to record moves before playing them.
Forfeit Time	Forfeit time is 30 minutes after the start of each session.
Ratings	Current ACF "normal/classical" rating list will be used for all players. If a player does not have an ACF Rating, their QJ or FIDE rating will be used. The event is ACF rated.
Organisers	The organisers reserve the right to make changes to arrangements for this tournament.
State Membership	It is essential for entrants to be members of their state chess association to participate in this tournament. E.g. CAQ, NSWCA, etc. Please note your membership status on form and required cost if not a current member.
Half Point Bye	A half point bye will be allowed for any one game if a competitor does not want to play six games and the bye is nominated with entry. (Excludes round 6)
<p>Blitz tournament</p> 	7 rounds - \$10 entry – registration with DOP before 6:15pm. Starts at 6:45pm (after dinner) with rounds every 15minutes. 6.45, 7.00, 7.15, 7.30, 7.45, 8.00, 8.15. Prizes 8.30.

<p>Food</p> 	The venue operator has organized to have a caterer at the event. This also means that no food from outside the venue will be allowed in or on RSL land. (Water OK). Please note that there are food outlets available near the venue (a short drive away).
Liquor	The Coolum-Peregian R.S.L holds a liquor licence, so all adults must sign in the R.S.L attendance book. Liquor will also be available on the Saturday.
About the venue	Link to Google maps is on the club website with the location marked. Located 300m from the beach and 800m from the start of Coolum's famous tourist strip with plenty of attractions for the family. Respect needs to be shown for the R.S.L memorabilia items on display at the venue. Items are not to be touched.
